## ARTISTS AND CRAFTERS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Artists and crafters will be charged a \$50 fee for any "bounced" check(s), and be required to submit a money order to cover the entry fee and/or booth fees. Fees not paid within one week of notification, will result in rejection from the event.

Outdoor booth space is limited to a 10X10 foot area. Covered booth space is limited to an 8 foot table. Artists and crafters with large displays can purchase multiple adjacent booths to display their creative pieces. Please do not go beyond your designated booth space.

Please send in your application form along with booth fees. All fees are non-refundable.

Covered booth space is limited. The covered booths are located in our pavilion.

We are on a first come, first served basis.

Our event will occur rain or shine. Please set up your booth accordingly.

Artists and crafters will be notified of their booth location, setup times, and other instructions, by May 1, 2020. Artists will not be permitted to switch booth locations the day of the event, even if there are artists or crafters that do not show. We will give every artists and crafter the same consideration.

There are no guarantees on the amount of sales you will receive. This is a community event on the Saturday and Sunday of Memorial Day weekend. Guests do not have a to pay an admission fee with hopes they will use that money to support you and purchase items from our artists and crafters.

Artists and crafters agree to be friendly and civil with fellow artists and crafters, employees of Making Memories at Wiegand Lake Park (MMWLP), and guests. You will be making an impression on our park, to all guests. Artists and crafters should notify a MMWLP staff member, if any issues arise and we will take appropriate action.

You are responsible for unloading your products and booth set up. We recommend this be done on Friday, May 22, 2020. Please plan accordingly.

Your booth must remain open and attended by the artist, crafter, or a person you assign to tend to your booth, for the entire duration of this event. This event takes place on Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24 from 10:00 a.m. thru 5:00 p.m. Please do not pack up early.

You are responsible to bring your own tent or canopy, if you have an outdoor booth. If you need electricity, it is your responsibility to let MMWLP know. You will also need to provide your own electrical cords that are in good working condition.

All sales will be handled by each artist or crafter. You will be responsible for tax collected. We are located in Novelty, Ohio and the Geauga tax rate is 6.75%.

We want to have a fun event for all exhibitors and guests. Our hope is to have an open house for the community that will also provide an outlet for you to display/sell your pieces or art.
